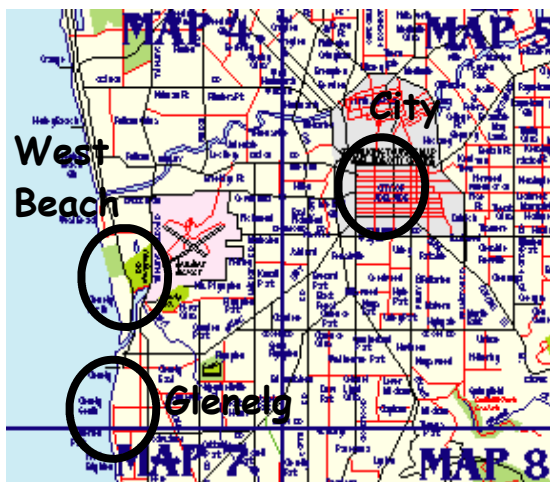
The general layout ...

Public transport

Other than as a tourist attraction, the tram is of no use. It runs between the city and Glenelg only. Link to the tram timetable:

The Shores Function Complex is located at bus stop 22.

Bus J1 City - West Beach - Glenelg 7 days.

Bus 278 City - West Beach - Glenelg weekdays.

Bus 276 City - West Beach, Monday to Friday, terminates at stop 18A (but the conference is a stop 22!). If you catch it you will have a 15 minute stroll to the conference.

All buses pick up and drop off in Currie and Grenfell streets in the city.

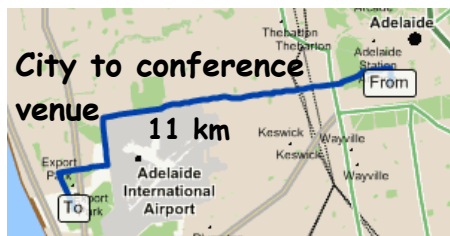
