Specialised Educational Reviews

SPELD SA's Specialised Educational Reviews screen students' skill development and performance across a range of areas as in literacy and numeracy, captured in that moment of time. These reviews are conducted by an experienced special education teacher and consultant.

Tutoring

The SPELD SA registered tutors play a vital role in assisting children and adults with specific learning difficulties, such as dyslexia. You will find the right support for your child by accessing the tutor allocation service at SPELD SA. A good teacher, using evidence based specialised teaching methods, can make a significant impact on a student's success and self-confidence.

Literacy Clinic

The literacy clinic provides students struggling to develop appropriate reading (decoding), spelling (encoding) and writing skills with effective, high-quality support using the evidence based Sounds~Write program. Clinic sessions are attended in small groups of up to 3 students.

Psychological Assessments

Assessments at SPELD SA are conducted by a registered psychologist, who specialises in learning difficulties, such as dyslexia, dysgraphia and dyscalculia. Assessments are for school-aged students (aged from 6 years) and adults.



Educational Consultations

Educational Consultations are offered as a service to parents of children who are struggling at school and adults concerned about their own learning difficulties.

Software Consultations and Training

SPELD SA's software advisors are teachers with specialist knowledge of current assistive technology and software for supporting students with learning difficulties individually or in the classroom.
